COURSE OVERVIEW

3-day (High Risk) CONDO course

Our 3-day CONDO course is designed for those who are deploying to a high-risk CONDO environment (e.g. Iraq / Afghanistan).

COURSE SYLLABUS

- CONDO organisation and responsibilities, welfare and discipline
- Military rank structures (if required)
- Mines / IEDs / UXOs
- Introduction to First Aid including CPR
- Personal security including ballistics, PPE and exploding ordnance
- Country security brief
- Vehicle / aircraft / helicopter procedures
- Kidnap and abduction

Certificates are valid for one year, after which 1-day CONDO Refresher training is required.

COURSE OVERVIEW

2-day (Low Risk) CONDO course

Our 2-day CONDO course is designed for MoD contractors who are deploying to a non-hostile, low risk MoD military sphere of operation, e.g. The Gulf.

COURSE SYLLABUS

- CONDO organisation and responsibilities, welfare and discipline
- Military rank structures (if required)
- Ballistic threats / danger areas / IEDs
- Introduction to First Aid including CPR
- Personal Safety
- The security threat / urban terrorism
- Kidnap and abduction

Certificates are valid for one year, after which 1-day CONDO Refresher training is required.

COURSE OVERVIEW

1-day CONDO Refresher

The MoD stipulates that the refresh rate for CONDO training is as follows:

“For contractors permanently Deployed in a geographical area for more than 2 years:

1. a complete CONDO IPDT package prior to Deployment and every two years, and
2. a refresher training package at each intervening 12-month point.

For contractors periodically Deployed in a designated Operational Area (OA):

1. a complete CONDO IPDT package prior to Deployment, and
2. a refresher training package to be completed on an annual basis.”

For most of our contractor clients, this means that Refresher training needs to be completed on an annual basis. We have therefore designed a 1-day CONDO Refresher training course that includes:

- DEFSTAN 05-129 and CONDO Updates
- Security threat update
- First Aid revision
- Tailored Q&A for High / Low Risk countries to be visited

Certificates are valid for one year, after which 1-day CONDO Refresher training is required.

COURSE FEES
